

Family Members of Spanish Citizens FOR RESIDENCE PURPOSES. RFX

(For Spanish Nationals residing in the Philippines with their family:

The application for the residence permit and visa is presented by the Spanish family member in the Philippines).

All Criminal Records, Medical Certificates and Civil Registry certificates that have not been issued by a Spanish Authority must be translated into Spanish and apostilled.

<u>All documents must be originals. If you wish to keep the original documents, you must provide</u>
<u>a copy them.</u>

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) National Visa Application Form, duly completed.
- 2) **One recent passport-size photo** with a white background affixed to the application form.
- 3) Valid passport or travel document, recognized as valid in Spain, with a minimum validity of one year.
- 4) **One photocopy** of the data page of the current passport.
- 5) Application form EX24.
- 6) Copy of identity card (DNI) or passport of the Spanish National.
- 7) **Proof of relationship** with Spanish National.
- 8) **Proof of** legal **dependence**, if applicable.
- 9) **Proof of legal residence of Spanish National** in the Philippines.
- 10) **Proof of legal residence of applicant** in the Philippines.
- 11) A **Sworn Statement from the Spanish National** affirming the non-existence of another spouse or partner residing in Spain.
- 12) Medical Certificate: Original and translation, of a certificate confirming that the applicant does not suffer from any disease that could have serious repercussions for public health, in accordance with the *International Health Regulations of 2005*. The original must be apostilled by the Philippine Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) and valid for three months from the date of issuance.
- 13) If the applicant is over 18 years of age, Criminal Record Certificate (NBI): Original and translation of the certificate issued by the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), apostilled by the Philippine Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), valid for six months from the date of issuance, as well as certificates from any countries where the applicant has resided during the past five years, duly legalized by the corresponding authorities.

NOTE: Other documents may be required.
